- Director's Assistant – The position of Director's Assistant shall have the following qualifications and perform the following duties:
 1. Be of the Christian faith, with a willingness and ability to relate to persons of different beliefs and practices within the Christian family.
 2. Provide a recommendation from a pastor.
 3. Pass a background check and fingerprinting.
 4. Ability to work a minimum of six hours per week during the current hours of operation of the ROC of Salem which are on Tuesday and Saturday evenings.
 5. Experience working with youth.
 6. Ability to work with and direct volunteers.
 7. During ROC of Salem operation, be responsible for enforcement of ROC of Salem rules and be accountable for such.
 8. During ROC of Salem operation, interact with youth and adult volunteers providing hospitality and communicating the mission of the ROC.
 9. Provide assistance to the ROC of Salem Director as directed.
 10. Accountable to the ROC of Salem Board of Directors.
 11. Participate in annual child safety training.
- Middle School Program Leader – The position of Middle School Program Leader shall have the following qualifications and perform the following duties:
 1. Be of the Christian faith, with a willingness and ability to relate to persons of different beliefs and practices within the Christian family.
 2. Provide a recommendation from a pastor.
 3. Pass a background check and fingerprinting.
 4. Ability to work a minimum of three hours per week during the hours of operation of the ROC of Salem on Thursday evenings with additional time for program preparation.
 5. Experience working with middle school children, ages 10 to 13 years old.
 6. Education or related experience in developing and implementing curriculum and activities appropriate for middle school children.
 7. Ability to work with and direct volunteers.
 8. During ROC of Salem operation, be responsible for enforcement of ROC of Salem rules and be accountable for such.
 9. During ROC of Salem operation, interact with youth and adult volunteers providing hospitality and communicating the mission of the ROC.
 10. Work in collaboration with the ROC of Salem Director.
 11. Accountable to the ROC of Salem Board of Directors.
 12. Participate in annual child safety training.
