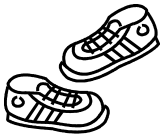
Dear Members of First Presbyterian Church,

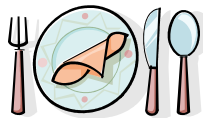
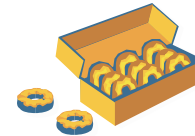
