### Ideas for Your Fall Clean-Up

As you are finalizing your yard clean up this fall, please remember the following:

- According to the CCH website, <u>cchenvironmental.org</u>, you can take your yard waste to JDS Landscaping at 46486 St. Rt. 14 in Columbiana (330-457-0652) or to Minerva Enterprises at 8955 Minerva Road in Waynesburg (330-866-3435).
- Remember to use the 30 gallon compostable bags provided by CCH and Home Depot to bag up the leaves from your yard. It is important that you use them because they will break down over time and can be chipped and turned into mulch with the leaves. Plastic bags are no longer used because they eventually have to be cut open and then added to the landfill.
- Remember you can also chop up those leaves as you
  mow your lawn. Chopped leaves add many valuable
  nutrients to your yard and make it lush and green next
  spring, and can also be spread on your garden adding
  valuable nutrients for it as they break down over the
  winter.
- Please don't put out hanging baskets, plants, etc. with your trash! The soil can be added to your gardens or around your shrubs and the plants can be added to your compost. (If you don't compost, maybe know someone who does.)
- And now that Halloween is over, those pumpkins would be great feed for someone's chickens or other farm animals. See if you can find someone to give them to. If not, they too will break down in the compost or in your garden.
